ANNOUNCEMENT

Admission of Graduate Students “MSc in Hospitality and Tourism Management”

1. The School of Economics, Business Administration and Legal Studies of the International Hellenic University invites interested parties to apply for the Postgraduate Programme of Studies "MSc in Hospitality and Tourism Management" for the academic year 2016-2017. All courses are taught exclusively in English.

The Academic Supervisor of the Postgraduate Programme of Studies is Assistant Professor Korina Katsaliaki, Director of the Programme and member of the General Assembly of the School. The academics teaching on the programme come from universities both from Greece and abroad.

2. The MSc programme leads to the acquisition of a Master's Degree. The official length of the programme is two full calendar years. This is a part-time programme (November till April) that includes taught courses and the completion of a master's dissertation.

3. The International Hellenic University accepts, after a careful selection process, graduates from Greek universities or equivalent institutions from abroad, as well as from Technological Educational Institutions in related subject areas.

The MSc in Hospitality and Tourism Management of the International Hellenic University provides students with a broad and comprehensive body of knowledge and skills development in order to help them manage Tourism units.

The main objective is the acquisition of knowledge that aims towards developing successful decision making strategies and critical evaluation techniques on issues which pertain to Management in the broader discipline of Tourism while at the same time to provide practical orientation in relation to administrative and strategic issues in this rapidly developing area, both at national and international level. The programme also aims to provide sound knowledge needed for the formulation of strategies for Tourism units and organisations, with an emphasis on environmental

law which permeates the discipline and which, in recent years has acquired increasing interest.

4. The selection of postgraduate students will be undertaken in accordance with the provisions of current legislation based on the grades received in first degree qualifications, the grades received on the thesis and undergraduate courses related to the MSc in Hospitality and Tourism Management, the candidate's certified proficiency in the English language, the candidate's curriculum vitae and recommendation letters.
5. Interested parties are invited to submit their application by November 4th 2016 or until places are filled, by following instructions at the link <http://www.ihu.edu.gr/index.php/admissions.html>. Application documentation must include the following:
 - A detailed curriculum vitae
 - Copy of the first cycle degree
 - Copy of the transcript of grades
 - Certification of English Language proficiency is demonstrated by submitting one of the following titles proving very good level: IELTS (6.5 or above), TOEFL (90 or above), TOEIC (850 or above). In case of absence of these, other certificates are also acceptable which prove, however, excellent knowledge of English, according to those standards designated by the Greek Authority ASEP. Candidates who do not possess the relevant certification may submit an application on the understanding that, in order to be allowed to commence Postgraduate Studies, they must submit such a certificate by November 4th 2016
 - Two recommendation letters in signed and sealed envelopes. Alternatively, the referees can send the signed recommendation letters to infoeba@ihu.edu.gr by their official institutional email address
 - Two passport size photographs
