

Orestis Kourakis is a Fulbright Fellow, specialised in archaeological photography. In 2013 he initiated an interactive platform for Ancient Greek and Roman collections as a visiting research scholar at Columbia University. Moreover, he initiated an interactive multisensory museum education project as a visiting artist in residence at Stevens Institute of Technology. In 2011, he has been selected by the Louvre Museum exclusive photographer for the 2011-2012 “Ancient Macedonia, the kingdom of Alexander the Great” exhibition at Louvre. He has been the official and exclusive photographer and cinematographer of the Archaeological Museum of Thessaloniki (Greece) since 2006 and has collaborated with many leading museums and institutions worldwide. He teaches photography and post production in the American College of Thessaloniki since 2010 and has given series of lectures on archaeological photography at many US’ institutions and at the School of Fine Art of the University of Granada. Apart from archaeological photography he has been the cinematographer and editor of awarded archaeological documentaries. His work has been published in numerous scientific books and journals internationally.
