


## Coursework submission

Click on the **Coursework** activity button.





Note: if your assignment requires you to submit more than one files, you need to create a compressed archive (.zip extension suggested) which will contain all files you need to submit and upload the compressed file to the e-learning platform. Otherwise, any file you upload will replace the one previously uploaded. A freely available piece of software which can help you create compressed files is 7-zip. You can download it here: <http://www.7-zip.org/> The name of the file you upload should not contain

your last name or any other identifying information except your student ID since the marking is blind. In fact, it is recommended that your filename includes your student ID so that your submission can be recognized without opening it.
